Parents provide their children the first expression of love and sense of security. As protectors and nurturers, parents set a foundation for leading and teaching children to be responsible.

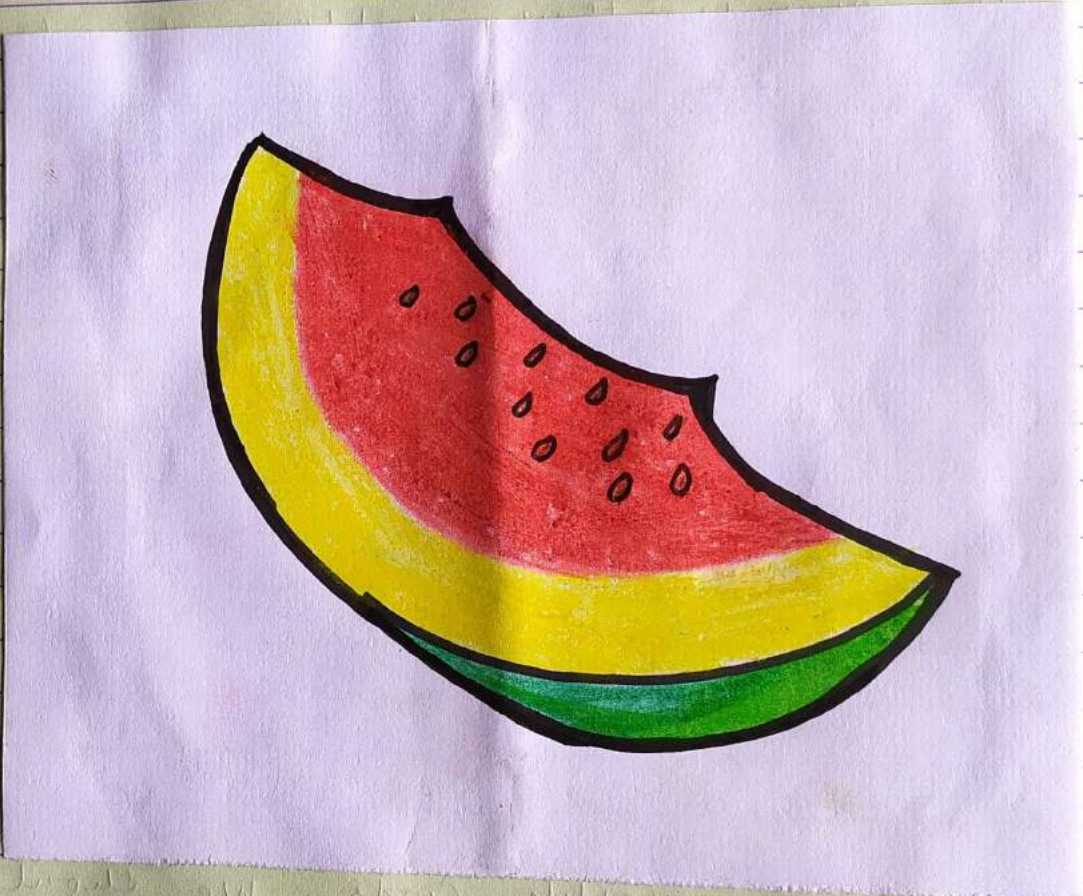
Marilyn Dalrymple from Lancaster, CA created Respect for Parents Day which is celebrated annually on August 1st.

Today the students did skit, speech on the importance of Raksha Bandhan. They danced, they tied Rakhi, they played different games and enjoyed a lot.



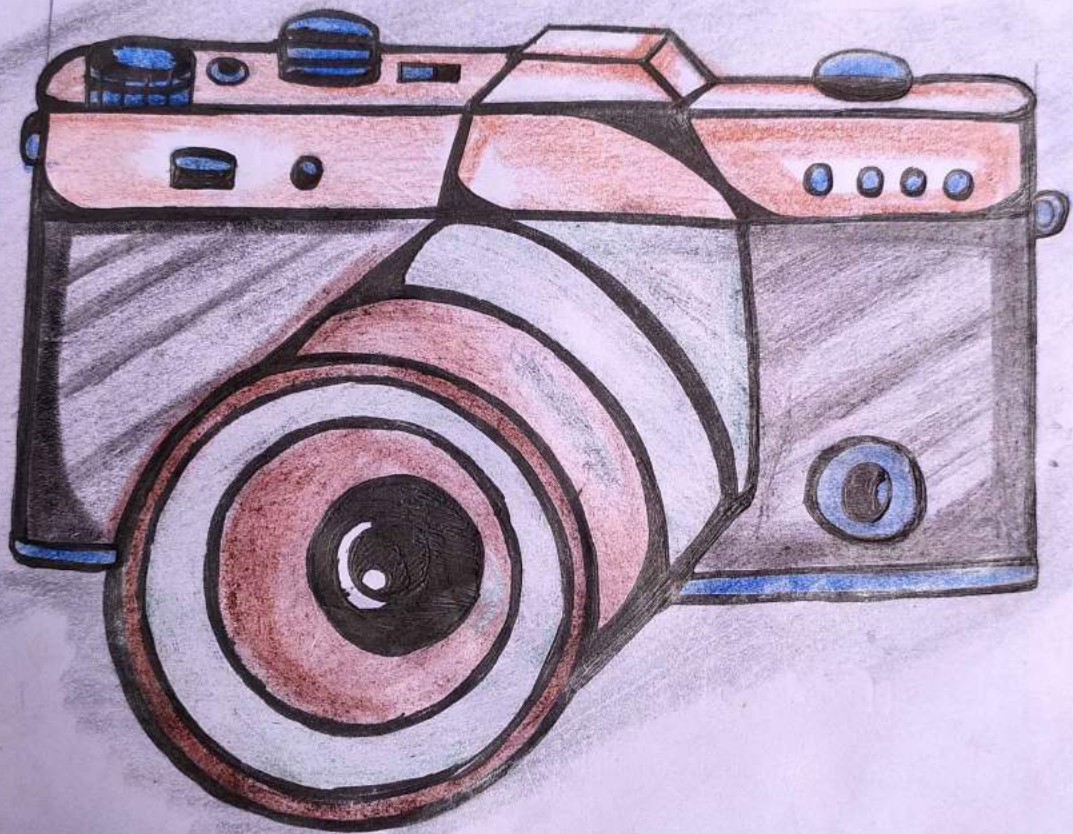

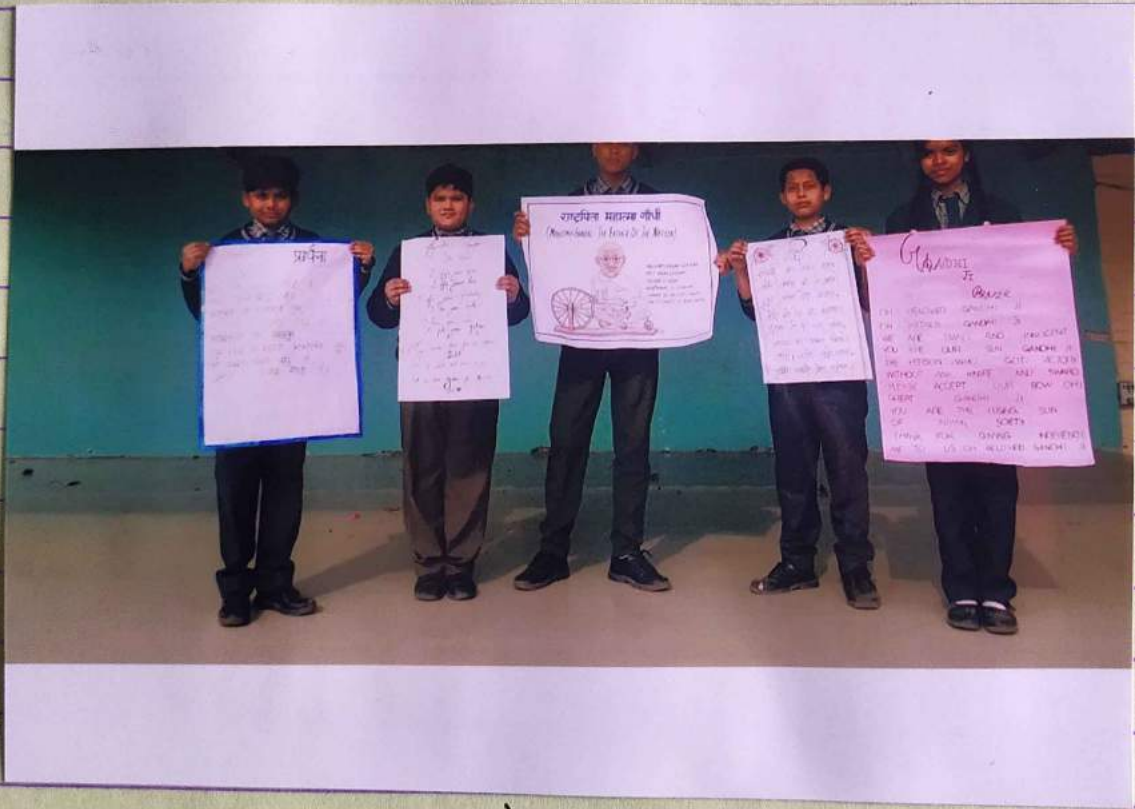

They were also told not to eat junk food because its very harmful and injurious to health.

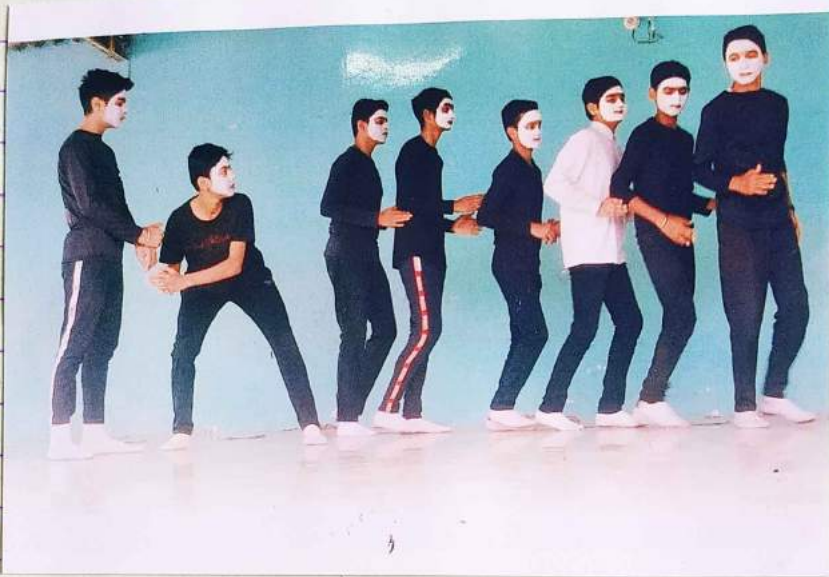

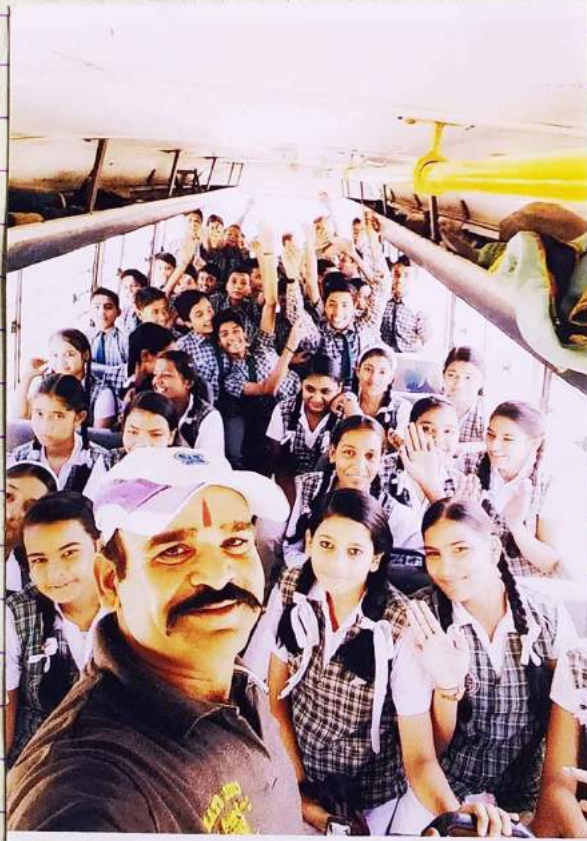
## NATIONAL WILDLIFE DAY



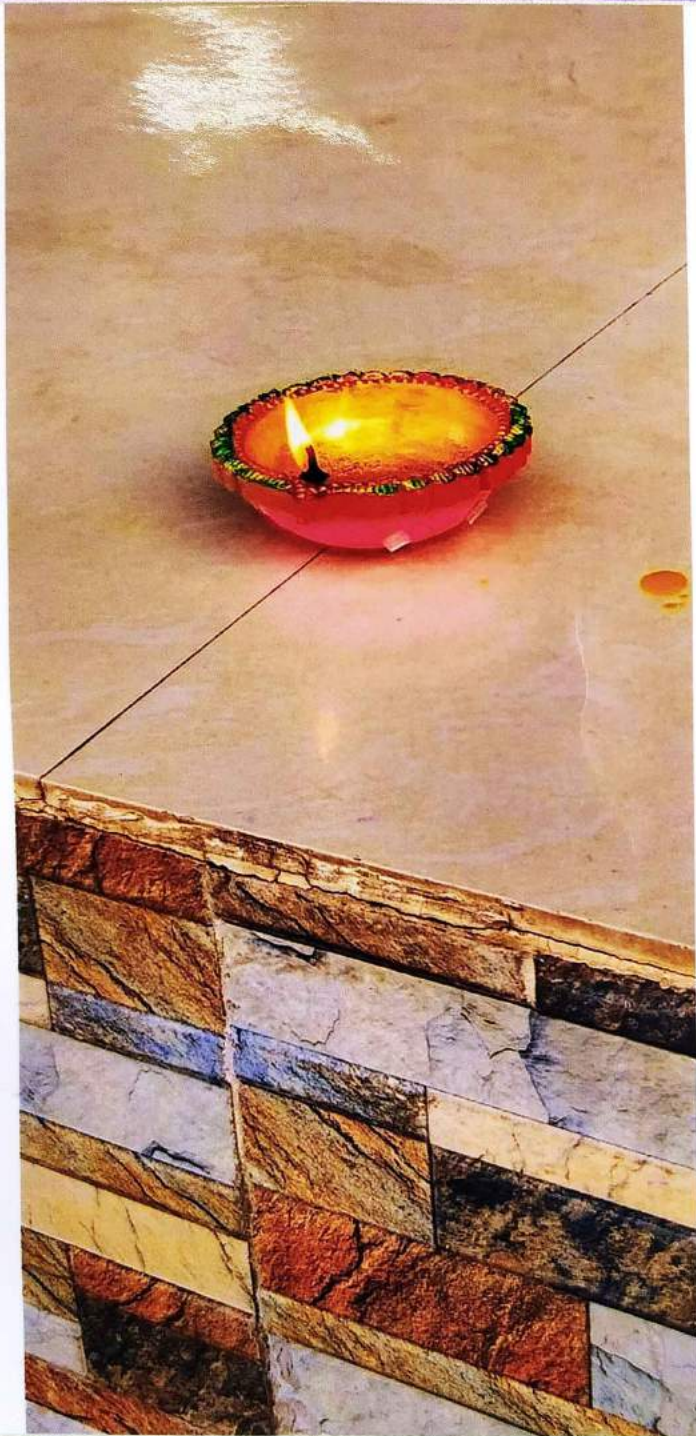
## NATIONAL SANDWICH DAY

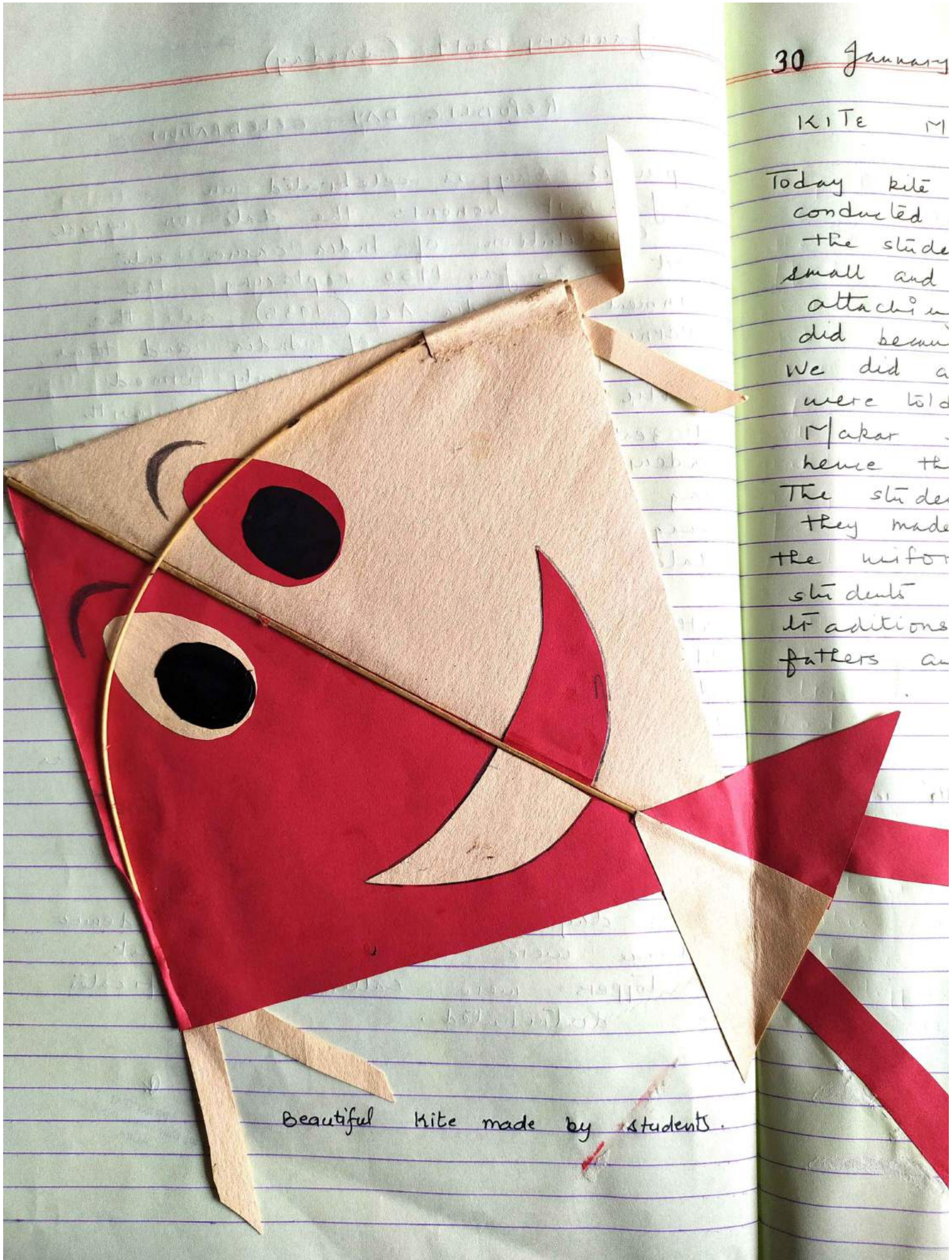
## REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

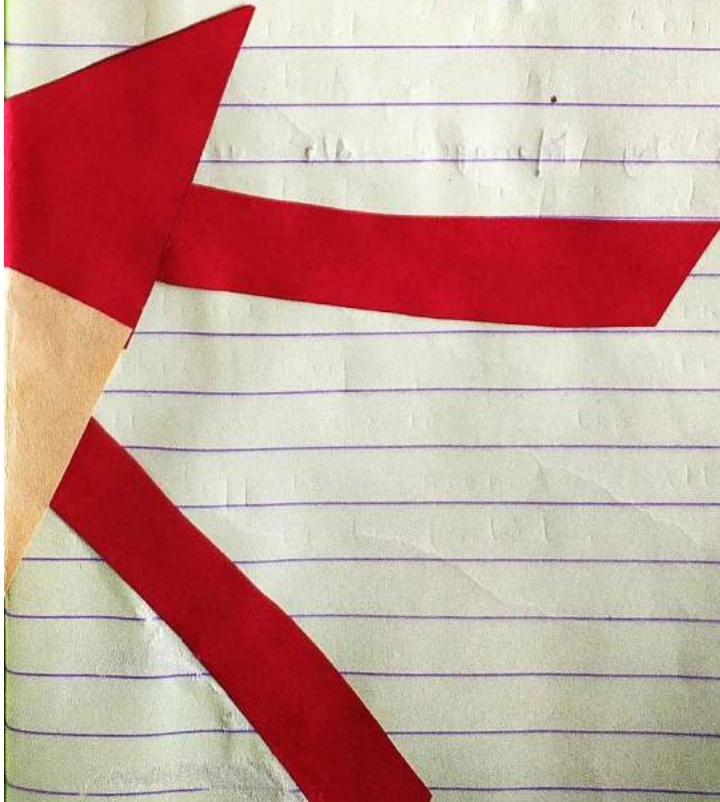

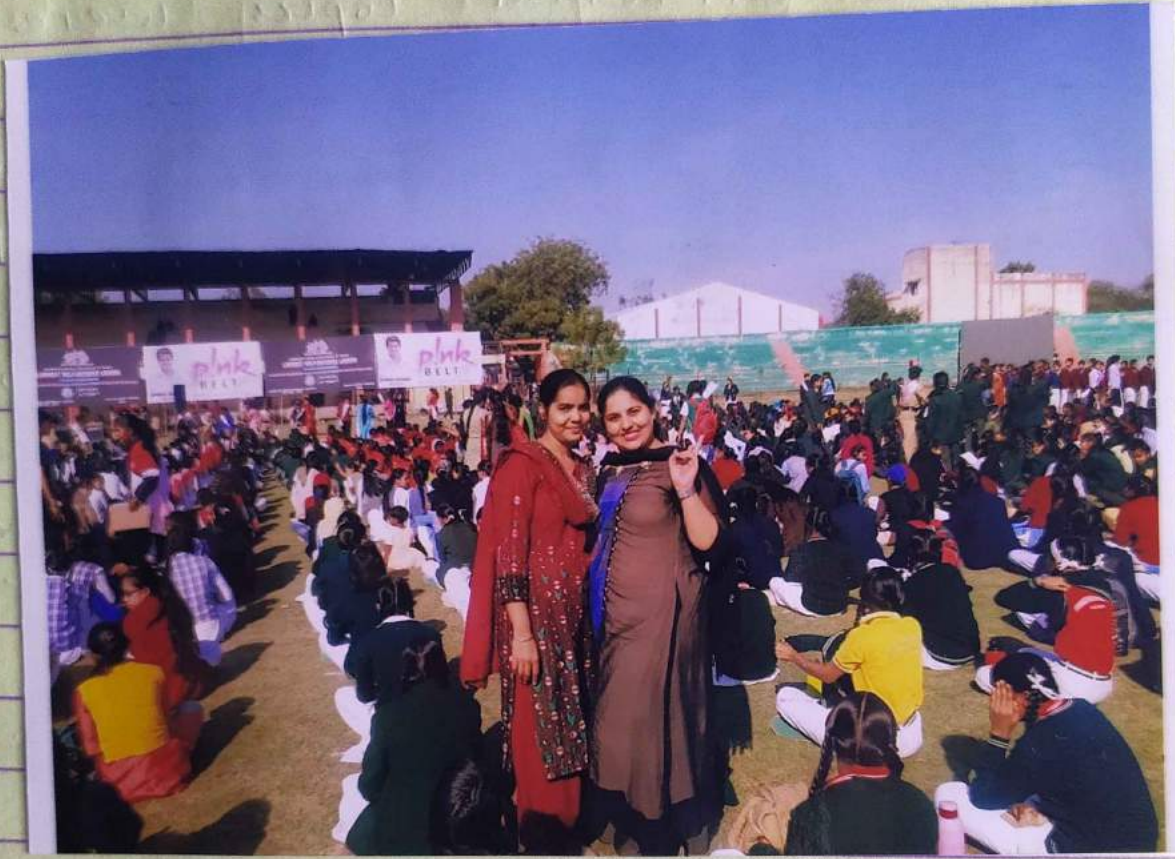
Mother Tongue Language Day

From time to time the policemen and lady counsellors from U.P government visit our school for discussing girls safety measures and regulations with the girls of our school. They train our girls and conduct a talk show related to safety measures. They have given the girls a Police Helpline Number 9410045561; on which they can call anytime whenever they feel they are in danger whether in school, home or at marketplace.

The lady counsellors told the girls to be very careful when they are alone.

The counselling session was very useful and it helped our girls to be more confident.

These kinds of counselling from UP government are very effective and helpful and the need of an hour for our girls students.
